These are some of the text messages I received from our church Planters who managed to send one:

Pastor Roger De Ocampo from Mabitac, Laguna: “Three people are dead within our neighborhood, we need help, please send canned goods, noodles, food and clothings”

Pastor Norman Dagdag from Marikina: We are back to zero, we have no clothes, please send us blankets and clothes and medicines. I will call you when the telephone lines and power are back”

Pastor July David: “Sir good evening! Nalubog ang bahay naming, walang natira sa mga gamit naming walang naisalba, lubog hanggang 2nd floor ng bahay, buti nakaligtas ang pamilya ko. (Our house was submerged entirely in floodwater, all our belongings are gone, we were not able to secure our clothes, the floodwater reached the second floor of our house. Good things my family is saved)

Pastor Daniel Casuga: Please help us Sir, please look at the pictures of our house, we have nothing....
