Dear Brethren of White Fields,

It has been a great privilege for me to know you and receive your support throughout these years. Your prayers have helped us a lot in the ministry. God has done many things and you have been a part of it all. In this final report, I would like to share with you all the things God has done and the goals we still have.

We began a wonderful ministry for the youth. The program is called Bible Club and we currently have more than 30 teenagers attending. By the grace of God we took 20 of these teens to summer camps from 2007-2010. The entire congregation helped them earn money by selling pies and cakes.

The adults in the church are either involved in the Sunday school or participate in the summer camps. We started a couples' meeting that deals with interpersonal issues and teaches the roles of the Christian couple. As a result of this, a new couple came to Christ and another couple is planning to marry in February. By God's grace, a family returned to the ways of the Lord. Praise God!

The women's meeting has grown a lot over the years. Meetings are held weekly to hold the women accountable. My wife has taught on several topics, such as Christian life, marriage and how to raise children.

We continue to broadcast a radio program called "Between you and God." We reach thousands of people in the city through this outreach ministry.

Last year, we started sharing the gospel door-to-door in a new neighborhood close to our church. It has approximately 250 families. I also had the opportunity to preach the word of God in several cities last year.

My family is growing spiritually; my children are involved in several ministries, including the youth meeting, Sunday school and the worship team. Daniel finished his first year of college. He is studying kinesiology. We are thankful our other son, Martin, passed a chemistry exam he has been trying to pass since 2008. He has moved back home for this semester and will have to travel 120 kilometers to class every day. Pray for his safety on the road. Our daughter Laura continues to study transverse flute and is teaching music. We are very thankful to the Lord for our children!

The Lord has blessed my wife and me with 25 years of marriage and has also blessed us in so many other ways. God is good!

We are thankful to White Fields and all the staff. We are also thankful to God for all those who have prayed for us and helped us financially. Thank you one more time for all you have done for us. May God bless you greatly!
