Dear Prayer Partners,

As you know, I had surgery with a number of complications. I spent March in almost total rest. Glory to God—I am recuperating well, yet I am still avoiding situations that need physical strength.

In March, the church moved from the location where we had been meeting. It was not the move we had planned, but we know we are under God's control. We had planned to move to a place that was more visible, easily accessible and more comfortable. However, there was an invasion next to the construction and because of that the work was stopped. Today we are meeting in a house with ample space, but located on a street with less visibility and difficult access.

Now we are looking for a location that can meet our needs in three areas: one, adequate space for our children (we have around 30); two, a location with easy access (there is a place in the center of the city, but we would risk losing our children); and three, a pleasant place where we can worship God. We have been praying about this. I am in contact with a man who has a place that would satisfy our needs, and negotiations are going well, except for the high rent required and that the construction is not finished. Please join us in praying for God's leading in this.

We had a women's gathering the last Wednesday of the month and around 30 women joined us, of whom half were visitors. Pastor Leide, leader of Good Samaritan House of Recuperation and the project Children in the Eyes of God in Açailândia was the speaker. It was a good time of fellowship and blessings from the Word. One of the visitors who had not been attending church for some time decided to become a member of the church along with her youngest daughter. The following Sunday her older daughter and husband also visited us.

We are planning for the church's anniversary and a Couples' Encounter in May. We are dreaming of having these events in the auditorium of a hotel in the city. Pray the Lord will make this possible.

Thank you for praying with us. We know that our labor is not in vain in the Lord.
