The new houses are not as good as the old, but they are nice, and my members are very happy. Secondly, the Lord has made it possible for six children from my Sunday school to receive an education. Finally, by the grace of God, the repairs on the roof of my house and fence have been completed. Thank you for your earnest prayers.

Our situation is becoming normal again since the destruction caused by the cyclone, and our weekly programs are on their normal schedule. Though my members are struggling for their daily survival, we are able to conduct all our weekly services and outreach ministries. I am thankful for the help of my overseers in many areas, especially in the follow-up ministry of new believers for whom they conduct Bible training twice a month. This is very effective in the lives of my members. Praise the Lord.

We are very sad that Mrs. Moe, age 25, was very ill upon her return from her visit to Irrawaddy, the area most affected by Nargis. The doctors diagnosed her with a severe case of HIV. She has now gone home to be with the Lord. Please pray for strength and comfort for her family and for her husband's salvation.

Some of my members don't have jobs since the cyclone, and it is very hard for them to find work. Most of them were working at a company that made bricks, but in the rainy season, the company stops production. Now my members are finding it difficult to meet their daily needs. Please pray for these families, that God will provide for them.

I would like to give my unceasing thanks to you all for your prayer and financial support. Your help is having a great effect on my ministry. May God bless you all.
