Dear Prayer Partners,

I had the opportunity to visit four villages in June and July. In these villages I shared the gospel by means of personal evangelism, and I thank God that I was able to meet and share with several people. Four of them have received Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Praise God!

I also shared the gospel with two families in another town—the families of U Kan and U Zaw. After sharing with them for two nights, they were really changed and closer to Jesus Christ.

Our weekly programs are running smoothly, but because it is the rainy season, attendance at my home cells and prayer meetings is down; some of the members are very busy with their field work. My children's Sunday school program is growing as more children have joined us.

Please let me share with you about the condition of one of my members, so that you can pray for him. U Thein suffered from TB for two years. During the time of his illness, my wife and I always prayed for his recovery. The Lord healed his sickness, and he was able to go back to his family as a new Christian. However, after he had been home for a while, he and his wife had problems. Without consulting me, he enrolled as a monk at one of the monasteries. His family members are very worried about him. Please pray that the Lord will touch his life and bring him back to his family. I am told that he has no peace at the monastery. Pray that he learns that his peace lies in the Lord Jesus Christ.

I have no permanent residence for my family; we are renting a house which we also use for worship services and prayer meetings. Since we are renting, we need to move if the owner needs his house. Because of this my family has had to move three times. It reminds me that we are strangers in the world. Please pray that we will be able to stay where we are this year. Pray also that our needs will be met during this worsening economic crisis.

I am so thankful and grateful to you all for your monthly prayer and financial support. I receive it regularly. Thank you very much. May God bless you all.
