It is always a joy to be able to communicate with you through these reports. How great it is that even though we are separated by a great distance, the love of God and prayer brings us together and makes this work a united effort.

Well, I would like to tell you that in this moment I am continuing to disciple young men who have come alongside me. We share a time of fellowship and study together because this is what they really need.

I am also still developing leaders within the church which brings me much satisfaction. These young people are so interested in learning from the word of God and putting it into practice by working in the two Bible clubs that we offer. On Saturdays they are busy working with the children. Indeed, I am blessed by these future leaders. Praise God!

I have been visiting a new couple that has started coming to church. Lucas and Emilce have two little girls; they are very interested in knowing more about Christ. Lucas heard the gospel when he was a young man, but when he got together with Emilce, the Lord was not in their lives. But now Lucas wants to return to the ways of the Lord and this had been causing problems for him. Give thanks to the Lord that Emilce liked our church and is willing to come and hear the word of God. We are praying for the salvation of this entire family and that their marriage will be restored. Please pray especially for Emilce.

I have also been in contact with a family that lives in a nearby neighborhood. The husband was a co-worker of mine and he is very interested in the gospel and wants to come to church. His wife wants nothing to do with us. We are praying for her and for their family; they have two children who are almost teenagers. Please join us in praying for their salvation.

We praise God for His work through us on Children's Day. We went out with the youth group and presented a show in Asuncion. It was truly wonderful because many adults and children received the Lord Jesus Christ into their lives. Pray for genuine conversions and for our follow-up to be effective.

The following weekend, we traveled 70 kilometers to present the same show. There were over 400 people in attendance, including children. The most exciting thing that happened was the salvation of an 81-year-old man! Then on Sunday we presented the gospel again at a church with 150 children present. They all heard the word of God; praise Him for allowing me to preach the gospel. What a blessing!
