By faith, the youth decided to purchase an amplifier with a microphone for the church meetings. They are getting ready to kick off a program to raise funds through refreshments, posters and jerseys in the neighborhood of Villa Industrial. Please pray for the youth because what they are doing isn't easy. We have lost some of our youth in that they no longer come to church, and our youth leader just left for the U.S. to study at Moody Bible Institute. The youth that are here and working hard for the Lord want to give all that they have. Praise God.
