Margie is now enrolled in the Bible school, and we praise the Lord that although the church is not financially stable, we are able to provide for Margie's transportation to school. Adelina is thankful that all her children are serving the Lord through our church. Please pray that the Lord will bless this family.

We are thankful for a new family in our fellowship—the Raizon family. My wife was able to help their daughter obtain a birth certificate which was needed to enroll in a university. They were very appreciative, so when we invited them to attend our service, they gladly accepted our invitation. Presently, Mrs. Riazon and her two daughters are faithfully attending church. They have heard the gospel, but have not yet openly expressed their faith. Please pray for their commitment, and pray that they will grow in their knowledge of God's word.

My wife Cora is very supportive in the church's ministry. She is now teaching more than 90 youth who are out of school and is in charge of the livelihood program for the parents. My son Daniel Carlo, who remains very active as a youth leader and as a member of the praise and worship team, will have his nursing board review in November. My youngest, Sheila Mae, is a second year college student and is also teaching in the children's Sunday school. Please pray that the Lord will sustain our family. The schooling of our children is a step of faith on our part, and we pray that the Lord will completely provide for their education, so that they can finish their respective courses.

We praise the Lord for the new members of our praise and worship team. They are a part of our school education youth group. Pray that we can reach out to them through this ministry.
