Pray that the Lord will work in their hearts.

This family is very poor; they grow vegetables in their yard to sell in the nearby market. Many times their income is not enough to provide for their daily needs, yet their poverty is not a hindrance for them. They are not ashamed of their living conditions, and they faithfully come to hear God's word.

The Cagadoc family members are active in the church. Her husband works abroad and is seldom home. However, despite her husband's absence, the family is able to cope well. Mrs. Cagadoc sometimes volunteers to cook for special group meetings, and her two daughters are thinking of joining the music team. Pray that the Lord will prepare her daughters' hearts as they become involved in this ministry. Pray also for me as I personally disciple and encourage them.

We started a new Bible study for a group of ladies in the church, many of whom are mothers. At first they didn't show much interest in the study, but as we developed relationships with them things began to change. They began to show more interest when we studied the roles of husbands and wives. They really responded to this topic and began to open up. One of the mothers shared how she was burdened because her child had stopped studying. Others in the group gave her encouragement. We prayed together and were very thankful that we were able to minister to each other. Pray that the Lord will continue to guide and bless this group of women.

Two of our church leaders, Sister Sofia Acunin and Ara Marquez who work in our children's and youth ministries, have attended a leadership training seminar. After the training, they shared with us how excited they are to apply what they had learned. I am really thankful to the Lord for molding these two ladies' hearts to become His servants for the furtherance of His gospel.

Brethren, please continue to pray for the brothers and sisters here as they serve our Father and our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Pray that their families will come to know the Lord and receive Him as Savior.
