I had the privilege of attending a ministerial fellowship recently where I learned a new discipleship strategy called “Seven by Seven”. It is a strategy in which a believer forms a group of seven people to disciple. We began using it in our church and growth is now beginning to become manifest by the grace of God. The young people, as well as the adults, are using the system. It is showing remarkable results. Jasmin, who is a new member of the church, is allowing us to use her backyard as a study place. Please pray that we will be able to bring people closer to the Lord through this method.

I started preaching on living in the kingdom of God last month. I hope that it will increase their knowledge about God’s kingdom—on how to enter and live according to Him. I am grateful to God for the positive response of the people; it was encouraging.

I also began assigning tasks to some of the new leaders. They are very willing to build the body of Christ. Myra, Renagene, Coline and my wife are all showing improvement and development in their ministries. At first they were fearful to lead, but now they are willing to share the power and love of God without fear. Coline, who works for a Korean company, is even witnessing to the president of the company! Please pray for these leaders and for their continued spiritual growth.

The nation experienced a rice crisis not too long ago, which raised the price of rice. The government has some rice that they sell for a less expensive price, but the lines in which one must wait are extremely long. I thought of using this as an opportunity to hand out gospel tracts to the people who are waiting. My wife and I also line up daily to buy rice. It takes us two hours before we are finally to the front of the line for purchasing. It really is a very difficult and hopeless situation for many Filipinos. Pray for us as we hope to strengthen our visitation ministry in order to encourage members and those in the community. Pray that the lost will readily receive the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Some of the church members’ children were dedicated to the Lord on May 15. I used this occasion to share the gospel with the unbelievers who were in attendance. At a White Fields seminar, I learned that we should preach the Word in season and out of season, so I do it whenever the Lord opens the door. Pray that the seeds are firmly planted.

Our ministry as a whole continues to create an impact in our target area. By the grace of God, we are growing qualitatively and in number. We are continually praying that the Lord will grant our wish that all our members will be involved in the ministry and that our vision in this place will be realized. Thank you very much for your prayers on behalf of our ministry. We pray for you, too. God bless you for all that you have done for the sake of the gospel.
