I am beginning to dream big for the Lord. I am very active in our cell group and with the youth. I feel I am safe and comfortable and I thank God for leading me to Pastor Marlon and his wife. I praise God for saving me and placing me in this Christian family who not only preaches the word of God, but is also concerned for my future. This coming vacation, I plan to go home and share the love of God with my family, especially my father who is now 92 years old. Please pray for their salvation.
