I always remember to claim His promise that He will never leave me nor forsake me. My pastor and this church have helped me to grow spiritually through their testimonies and encouragement." The oldest man in our congregation is Kuya Ted. He used to be a journalist and now assists in leading devotions. He is single and lives with his brothers and sister. The third man is Kuya Mar; he is a construction worker. He gave his life to Christ while working in Saudi Arabia. We have a new family that we are in contact with—the Bangasan family. God used one of the children, Hanna, to bring the gospel into the home. Hanna attended our VBS for the last two summers.
