One brother offered his keyboard to be played during our services, but we don't have electricity. We also need to find housing for my family and me. Right now we live quite a distance away and this causes our services, particularly our evening prayers, to start late. Please also be in prayer for us as we consider the plans for a permanent structure. And finally, please be in prayer for the believers here, that the Lord will raise up mature men and women. We need Sunday school teachers, because there are more kids than adults. I also need mature believers to help me with the work. Please pray with us for all the mentioned challenges.

I thank God Almighty for His work in this place. I believe God has called me to suffer with this church. Please pray I will not be tempted to leave. It is my desire to finish what God has started with His help. Thank you very much.
