Dear Prayer Partners,

The Tigane Baptist Church is growing spiritually and developing their stand for evangelistic outreach. The previous EE III training is our ultimate tool in sustaining this outreach program. We appreciate how the Lord is giving us many opportunities in our door-to-door ministry to share the gospel. Attendance at worship services continues to increase because of this and the fact that the members are inviting their friends and relatives to come. In addition, the parents of the Sunday school children have been encouraged to visit their children's classes in order to see how we are teaching them. We are earnestly praying that this approach will lead to the parents' attendance at worship services.

Our young men have a weekly prayer meeting where they are encouraged to develop a daily quiet time with the Lord. They are also mentored in preaching and outreach to learn how to witness to their age group. This weekly time has been very beneficial to these young men, many of whom do not have the opportunity to socialize with their biological fathers. However, the youth group has suspended its midweek activities due to the activity of gangsters in the area. One of our church members was murdered on his way home from work. This has caused fear in the community, and people are not venturing out. The local pastors approached the tavern operators about this problem, but they refused to be cooperative.

We are presently working on an evangelism action plan to visit our local prison where we want to impact the lives of those who have been wasted by the enemy. We have a new member who was recently released from 15 years in prison and is on fire for the Lord. His testimony of what the devil has done in his wasted life is breaking the hearts of listeners. He praises God for giving him a second chance. Pray that he will be used in our prison ministry.

The Letlhabile Fellowship is growing. They are doing evangelism and I am teaching them how to present the gospel and disciple new converts. The youth department is still small and needs a stable leader who has a passion for the young people's spiritual growth.

The police, school and clinic ministries are doing well and continuing to grow. We have seen God work wonders through our counseling program with members of the police force and are now hearing testimonies of God's grace.

Two of my daughters have had car accidents—one sustaining head injuries. Pray that we will maintain our Christian witness as we face these spiritual and financial challenges. We praise God despite what happens.

May the Lord be praised and worshipped in our lives.
