Dear Prayer Partners,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

I wish to thank God for His grace. During June and part of July, I was suffering from a muscle spasm in my neck. By His grace, I am healed and back doing His work.

During the month, I managed to visit five leaders out of the six I had hoped to visit. My purpose in visiting them was to strengthen them after the political violence that had affected the area. I wished to give them the assurance that God remains faithfully with us despite any difficulties we may face. The places I visited were Mapane, Mahwanke Mayezane, Sizeze and Makwe.

I was also able to hold two revivals, one at Gqalaza II and another at Mapane. Both were successful and bore fruit. I thank God that at Gqalaza thirteen ladies gave their lives to the Lord. At Mapane, something truly unusual happened. Seven married men received Christ. In this region, married men had never before given their lives to God. Pray that they will be the first of many to come to the Savior. Pray also that the word of God will take root in the hearts of others who heard the gospel, so that many will come to know the Savior.

The major issue for us now is to make follow-up visits to these new converts and begin to disciple them. To this end I have given my mature members and church leaders the task of visiting those who gave their lives to Christ.

In the future I wish to hold a week long revival both at Mawaza and at Mlowezi. Please pray that the Lord will oversee these plans and go ahead of us to prepare hearts.
